E.39-10.15 APOLOGIES

Apologies for absence were received and accepted from Councillors K Francis and E Harvey.

E.40-10.15 DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS

There were no interests declared at this point in the meeting.

E.42-10.15 BROSPA Presentation

E.43-10.15 SMARTWATER PRESENTATION

DEVOLVED SERVICES E.46-10.15

Members discussed the possibility of taking on services devolved from Herefordshire Council.

The Clerk advised that a response had been received from Herfordshire Council's Localities and Engagement Officer regarding Church Lane public toilets (refer C.59-09.15) advising that they were not aware of any new decision in relation to the closure of the toilets, as a result of the current budget consultation.

E.47-10.15 BUDGET 2016/17

E.48-10.15 CEMETERY

The Deputy Clerk explained that the new electricity supply to the Chapel/Cottage which was being delivered by Western Power would require payment up front of £5,900. Western Power will dig an exploritory hole just outside the cemetery. If a supply is present at this location then a reduced cost will be incurred and the Council would receive an proportionate refunded amount. If the supply is not present at this location it would need to be connected from across the road, and the full cost would be incurred. This is normal practice when the supply can not be identified.

RECOMMENDATION TO FULL COUNCIL: That funds are released to

That funds are released to pay for the works required for Western Power to install a new electricity supply for the Chapel/Cottage in the sum of £5,900.

Q64 - Specific streets and walkways improvement suggestions Response: Recreation Ground covered by LTC working party, Market House already covered by LTC. All other areas rest with Herefordshire Council.

Q72 - Which environmental schemes should be seen more in Ledbury.

Obj 1: To encourage the development of volunteer groups to implement schemes for the management of local woodland for timber and wildlife, for the development of wildlife corridors and the management of public spaces to encourage flowers and wildlife

Response: This is being enabled through Greenspaces and CPRE.

Obj 2: To encourage the Ledbury Allotment Association to promote the availability of allotments and the work they are doing in this area.

Response: This is not a role for LTC.

Obj 4: To establish a community garden group

Response: LTC does not agree and this should be co-ordinated with LIB and U3A.

Obj 5: To promote greater awareness of existing green waste collection service

Response: LTC does not agree.
