1.	<u>181724</u>	Proposed works to T1 English Oak (Quercus robur). Tree has significant basal decay and awkwardly spreading ungainly canopy that doesn't lend itself to an attractive shape of reduced. Would like permission to essentially pollard the tree, but really first to retain the main stem as a stable, living habitat, with no long term plan to re-establish full canopy – owing to the decay. T2 – Black Pine (Pinus nigra). Tree is healthy but has some residual snow damaged limbs which require removal. Additionally its close proximity to the property makes it a significant risk. Would like to reduce overhanging laterals by 20% at <b>The Lodge, Ledbury HR8 1JA</b>
