The students will be working alongside Stephen (the blacksmith) to design the art work with visits to the school in the first instance (this process has already started). The students will then go to Stephen's workshop over a number of weeks and produce this art work made of metal and this will be placed on a wall at school. This project will assist the students with their social skills as well as team work. Some of them don't get the opportunity to socialise and communicate with other adults except their own family.
