P240. APOLOGIES

Apologies were received from Councillors Manns & Vesma

P245. **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST** 

No declarations of interest were received.

P245. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The Town Clerk advised Members that she had received both supporting and non-supporting letters in relation to application number 201718. She had also received correspondence from concerned residents regarding the cycling on Church Lane. Residents believed that there were Byelaws in relation to public right of way and asked whether the council would provide signage.

Councillor Harvey suggested contacting Herefordshire Council to find whether there is a Byelaw in place on Church Lane.

#### P248. PLANNING CONSULTATIONS

1. Planning Application 201718 - East of Dymock Road, Ledbury. Herefordshire, HR8 2JQ

Councillor Bannister noted that there were 12 letters of support and 15 letters of objection on the Herefordshire planning portal in relation to planning application 201718. However, he advised that only 3 of the 12 supporting letters were from Ledbury residents. Councillor Harvey felt that a response should come from Full Council as opposed to the planning committee. She suggested going back to planning officers with an interim response and to note that Full Council will make further comments when documentation becomes available. Councillor Harvey suggested that Ledbury Council contacting Ledbury nurseries to ask whether they were at full capacity and whether an extra nursery would be beneficial to the town alongside the growth plan for the town.

Councillor Bannister advised that the planning application did not support the NPPF and therefore felt that it would have a negative effect on the town.

Councillor Howells proposed that members defer the application until further documentation is available. Councillor Harvey agreed with Councillor Howells statement and noted that it would be beneficial to engage in the local trader community to ask for their opinions.

RESOLVED: That the planning application be deferred to the next Economic Planning and Development Committee.

2. Planning Application 201956 – Parkway House. Little Woolpits Lane, Parkway, Herefordshire, HR8 2JG

3. Planning Application 202014 – Oakland House, South Parade, Ledbury, Herefordshire. HR8 2HB

4. Planning Application 202016 - Oakland House, South Parade, Ledbury, Herefordshire. HR8 2HB – Listed building consent

#### **RESOLVED: NO OBJECTIONS**

5. Planning Application 202100 – Changes to the design – Sequani, Ledbury. Herefordshire. HR8 1LH

Councillor Howells raised concerns in respect of the colour choice of the proposed cladding on the new building, he noted that the colour did not support the AONB design code and subsequently would have an impact on the Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.

Councillor Harvey also suggested the council highlight the importance on lighting and light pollution to meet the "Dark Skies" requirements.

RESOLVED: NO OBJECTION subject to the colour scheme on the building being compliant with the design guide criteria of the AONB and the correct lighting being installed in line with "Dark Skies" and AONB Guidance.

Councillor Harvey encouraged the Tennis club to investigate adopting a planting scheme.

#### P249. PLANNING DECISIONS

Councillor Harvey updated members on the landscaping at St Katherines and advised that the revised planning application for the landscaping had been approved. She explained that she had contacted to local stakeholder's including Ledbury Town Council to ask whether they would like the landscaping to be community led as opposed to Herefordshire Council.

The Town Clerk advised that she had received a latter for a concerned resident regarding.

Councillor Bannister reminded residents that the Town Clerk was going to investigate whether there is a Bye Law on Church Lane.

Councillor Harvey advised that she had also received health and safety concerns regarding some cyclists using the foot path on Tilley's alley onto the High Street.

Councillors Bannister and Howells noted that the working party 'Major Planning applications' was missing from the report.

## P254. RESPONSE FROM HEREFORDSHIRE IN RESPECT OF X-RAY SERVICES IN LEDBURY

Members were provided with a response to the letter of complaint that the Clerk sent in respect of the x-ray services in Ledbury.

Councillor Harvey suggested that the Council acknowledge the letter and propose that the Council ask to be notified of any future changes to the service provision.

After a lengthy discussion, members agreed that the Council respond to the NHS CCG to ask what their plans are to provide Ledbury with hospital facilities with a view to a meeting in the future. It was also proposed that The Town Clerk would also ask for a cost analysis how much it would costs residents to travel as opposed to the Herefordshire's cost to stay in Ledbury.

#### **RESOLVED:**

- 1. That members receive and note the correspondence from the NHS CCG
- 2. That the Council respond to the NHS CCG to ask what their plans are to provide Ledbury with hospital facilities with a view to a meeting in the future, and that they provide an analysis of how much it would costs residents.

Councillor Bannister proposed that he contacts members via email to arrange a meeting.

#### P256. SLOW WAYS PROJECT

Members were provided with a report in relation to an initiative in respect of mapping footpaths in Ledbury.

Councillor Harvey suggested contacting sustainable Ledbury and other local groups who would be interested in the initiative and create a press release.

- 2. That the Town Clerk create a press release inviting individuals or local groups to ask whether they would be interested in the Slow Ways project initiative.

Councillor Harvey updated members on the consultation as a County Councillor and suggested organising a sperate meeting of car parking charges to discuss a response to the consultation.

# P258. HEREFORDSHIRE HOUSING AND ECONOMIC LAND AVALIBILITY ASSESSMENT

Members were provided with correspondence from the Herefordshire Council Economy and Place Directorate asking whether Parish Councils would be willing to provide examples of site assessment work in relation to the NDP.

Councillor Howells proposed that the Council agree to share the landscape capacity assessment which will be available at the end of the year.

RESOLVED: That the Council agree to share the landscape capacity assessment and site assessment work with Herefordshire Council when completed.

#### P259. GEOSITE MAINTENANCE IN KNAPP LANE QUARRY

Members were requested to give permission to Geosite maintenance in Knapp Lane Quarry.

The Clerk explained that the site is a disused quarry dug into the hillside of Dog Hill Wood which Ledbury Town Council own. She explained that the proposed work would be to expose the Aymestry Limestone on the back face of the quarry and to improve the access path from the road.


Members agreed that they would like to help where possible, including providing signage if needed.
