ROUNDABOUTS

Purpose of Report

The purpose of this report is to provide Members of the Economic Development & Planning Committee with information on the roundabouts which have been issued with a Licence to cultivate in Ledbury.

Detailed Information

At the meeting of the Committee held on 10 September 2020, Members asked the Clerk to provide a list of the roundabouts which have a licence to cultivate on them and who currently holds those licences. The Clerk was also asked to investigate whether the new roundabout on Leadon Way had been adopted by the Council or whether it was still with the developers.

The following list has been provided by Fiona Miles of BBLP:

- Licence No 1066 Gloucester road roundabout, "Swallow" roundabout, sponsored by helping hands issued December 2015 swallow sculpture subject to a separate licence
- licence No 1101 little Marcle road roundabout, sponsored by fruit company up Little Marcle Road, got the birch trees on issued October 2017
- licence No 1103 new Mills Road roundabout, sponsored by Gale Breaker issued November 2017
- licence No 1121 Hereford road roundabout, sponsored by 3 counties vineyard – issued May 2020
- agreed but licence not yet drawn full pitcher roundabout
- not licensed and not sure if it is our responsibility yet or in the hands of the developer – new roundabout of Martins way

Fiona Miles, BBLP Licencing and Enforcement Officer has advised that she will investigate whether the council have adopted the roundabout on Leadon Way.
