Re-dedication of War Memorial and Church Service

• Jennifer Harrison provide contact details for Joanna Brace (Ruddock) in order to invite her to the unveiling of the Memorial. Joanna designed the World War 11 'airman and planes' tile on the Memorial.

RESOLVED: That the Clerk to write to Mrs Brace and invite her as a special guest. Letter sent

- Town Clerk updated that Mr Heaton had been invited as a guest of honour for the rededication of the War Memorial following its refurbishment, and this is all in hand, more details of this arrangement to follow.
- Mrs Hill is overseeing the list of families of those who lost their lives in second world war. They will be invited to attend Re-dedication and Church Service and to be given priority place at Memorial.
- Mayor will read the declaration of the end of the War at the War Memorial on 8 May 2020.

Street Party

- The Street Party to take place 4.00-7pm approximately, in High Street from Junction of Bye Street to Top Cross – subject to a road closure being in place;
- Keith Swingler (Landlord of The Brewery Pub) has expressed an interest in providing a singer for entertainment. The singer had been approached and the Clerk had been advised that the singer is available and has agreed to perform free of charge;
- Tim Keyes of Ledbury Bells to be approached to see if they will be available to help ring in the peace at 7pm;
- Volunteers to be encouraged to help with the day, Council staff to advertise on social media and website;

- People will still be asked to bring their own chairs and possibly a table, and some food and drink;
- Discussion on contacting the Traders Association to envisage whether they would like to be a part of the day. Cafés and Restaurant may want to open and contribute towards the day's commemorations. Councillor Howells mentioned that he had been talking to the Traders Association and advised that they had expressed an interest in holding a window display competition for this occasion. Agreed that this would be great for the town and that the Mayor and two other judges be selected nearer the time.
- Town Council will approach Hereford Council to ask for a road closure from 6.00 pm – 7.00 pm and possible exemption of "No Alcohol" restrictions for High Street for one day. Public Houses to be approached to see if they would like to see if they would like outside bar. (note correction from 6pm to 6am from previous notes)
- Brenda said that it would be good to have some games identified for the children with the road being closed. Discussion on types of games to have and who may like to oversee this (Hopscotch etc)

RESOLVED: Town Council to approach Christina Thorpe (LYAS) and Sally Holliday (Youth Council) to see if they would like to ask the Youths of Ledbury to help with this and give them opportunity to take part in organising old-style games.
