The small village of Sterksel lies in the south of the Netherlands approximately 17kms south east of Eindhoven. The cemetery is within the grounds of the Monastery, which was used as a hospital by the British Army from September 18th, 1944, for about a year.

Edward Bevan is buried in Row A. Grave 8.
