Dear Angie,
Please find below my report:-

We have received briefings on the Children's Commissioners report for Herefordshire Children's Services which is now being considered by the Secretary of State and the Minister's decision is imminent.

Hereford has been promised nearly £20 million from the Levelling Up Funds, but it was a disappointment that Ledbury and the other Market Towns were not awarded any monies.

We have received notification of a new proposed approach to the delivery of two Super Hubs in Herefordshire. However, a business case was developed in 2019 and approved at full council in Feb.2020 when we were told that Ledbury had been allocated as one of the Super Hubs and we had meetings with officers to that effect. Despite my requests for updates on this no further information was forthcoming and nothing more was heard! Now it seems that applications will be necessary if Super Hub status is to be awarded.

I am pleased to report that speed tubes have been put down on the Hawk Rise Estate to monitor the speeding vehicles on the Estate. Nearly 100 residents have signed a petition which has been sent to Transport and which asks that robust speed enforcement is to operate on the Estate.

I attended the Parish meeting concerning the Ledbury Hunt and S106 monies which passed off without too much aggression.

We had a Members Briefing on an introduction to the new 106 Delivery Team and an overview of new approaches and delivery mechanisms

As I write this the High Street and Top Cross are in chaos, due to the works being undertaken by Western Power and Balfour Beatty. We, along with other traders, are seeing no customers and this is due to continue all this week!
