# **LEDBURY TOWN COUNCIL**

Report from the Christmas Lights Working Party held on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2015 in the Town Council Offices

1. **Apologies** received from Kat Griffiths (Bamboo) and Cllr Francis.

2. **Report of meeting** held on 1st June was accepted.

a. Discuss and agree how to alleviate the queuing problems.

It was agreed that: the Burgage Hall would be the venue for the grotto, this would alleviate any queuing issues. The cost to remain at £3 entry to include a gift.

**Action:** MB to ensure that the Burgage Hall booking for 28th November has been confirmed and to book Friday 27th to allow for set up.

b. Grotto Signage:

**Action:** Elaine and Jayne to arrange signage for the grotto.

c. Agree allocation of tasks.

d. Discuss and agree 'Christmas Wonderland' grotto theme.

e. Discuss and agree the idea of a Portable Ice Rink & Bouncy Castle – further discussion with location choice (now St Katherine's car park) and prices to be confirmed along with availability.

**It was agreed:** No to go ahead with this option due to the expense.

**f. Toy auction venue:** Dee informed the meeting that she was expecting c150 people to visit Ledbury, from Birmingham, to take part in the toy auction.

**It was agreed:** that the toy auction would be best placed, on a trailer, tagged onto the market area.

- Dee Knight to inform MB asap if unable to provide the trailer.

# g. Flea Market venue.

**It was agreed that:** having made the decision to allocate the Burgage Hall to the grotto venue; St Katherine's Hall would be the ideal venue for the Flea Market.
