- d To arrange barrier manning (HM)
- e. To contact traders and make them aware of road closure (HM, EF & AW)
- f. To arrange all aspects of Dickensian Market promotion (HM & AW)
- g. To arrange Morris Dancers and additional entertainment including Victorian re-enactment actors and a photographer (HM)

It was also agreed that a small Medieval re-enactment 'Mike the Knight' event was staged with two half hour displays of dancing and fighting [cost £400] (DB, NR & JR)
