Sirs

Please accept this as a formal complaint about the stile on ZB19 as per recent exchange of email with Mr Francis.

The stile presents difficulty for those of short stature or infirmity to climb over and there is no provision for dogs to get under or round the stile other than being carried over.

According to Herefordshire.gov.uk #9854:

Landowners are generally responsible for gates and stiles on a public right of way. You must ensure path users can use them without difficulty.

and

Dogs are allowed on all route types but must be kept under close control at all times.

So the current stile is in contravention of these responsibilities and the lower step is now loose and dangerous.

Given the proximity to the main road, a gate would be a far better alternative.

Please ensure this matter is on the Agenda of the next Environment and Leisure Committee meeting (26th May) and I will endeavour to attend if I can be back from London in time.
