

## **Ledbury Neighbourhood Development Plan**

## Information Statement

Herefordshire Council gives notice that a Referendum relating to the Ledbury Neighbourhood Development Plan will be held on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> December 2018.

The question which will be asked in the referendum is:

Do you want Herefordshire Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Ledbury to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?

The referendum area is identified on this <u>map</u>. The referendum area is identical to the area which has been designated as the Ledbury Neighbourhood Development Plan area.

A person is entitled to vote in the referendum if on Thursday 6th December 2018:-

- He or she is entitled to vote in a Local Government Election in the referendum area; and
- His or her qualifying address for the election is in the referendum area. A
  persons qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register
  of electors, the address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be
  registered.

The referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the referendum is £2362, plus the number of persons entitled to vote in the Referendum by reference to which that limit has been calculated (7149 electors x 0.059p) is £2783.79

The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures which are similar to those used at Local Government Elections.

The specified documents are:

- The Ledbury Neighbourhood Development Plan;

- A Decision Statement of the Local planning Authorities satisfaction that the draft Neighbourhood Development Plan meets the basic conditions specified by statue and complies with the provision made by or under section 38A and 38B of the Planning and Compulsory Act 2004; and
- A statement setting out general information on town and country planning including neighbourhood planning and the referendum.
