The notice provides information on how to view the draft revised plan online, borrow paper copies, and complete the Response Form. It includes a QR code and a link to the survey monkey form. The notice concludes with the deadline for responses: "All responses must be received by 11.59pm on Saturday 19th 2022".

In accordance with Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, Part 5, 14(a)-(c) notice is hereby given that a formal pre-submission public consultation on the draft revised Ledbury Neighbourhood Development Plan will start at 00.01am on Saturday February 5th 2022 for a period of 6 weeks ending at 11.59pm on Saturday 19th March 2022.

The revision of the Ledbury Neighbourhood Development Plan has been developed to help deliver the local community's requirements and aspirations for the plan period up to 2031. The Plan has been created through listening to the views of the residents of the Parish. The Plan will provide a means of guiding, promoting and enabling balanced and sustainable change and growth within the designated area of Ledbury Town and Parish.

Ledbury Town Council invites comments on the draft revised plan. All responses received will be considered by the Town Council to inform a final revised version of the Plan. This revised version of the plan will then be submitted to Herefordshire Council, as the Local Planning Authority (LPA), for examination by an independent examiner.

The draft revised plan may be viewed online on the council website at www.ledburytowncouncil.gov.uk/en-gh/ndp-documents or be emailed to residents on request to the Town Clerk at clerk@ledburytowncouncil.gov.uk. Copies are also available for inspection at Ledbury Town Council Offices and the Ledbury Library during their normal office hours.

Paper copies of the plan may also be borrowed from Ledbury Town Council Offices. A number of drop-in consultation events in the council offices and online Zoom sessions advertised on the website, social media and on posters, will also be organised during the consultation period.
