Dear Nicola,

Sorry for the delay in responding. The Minutes make a few references to the CCG and their plans and involvement. We would prefer to agree the Minutes as a true reflection of their position, and if not, then they can suggest amendments. I will forward the Minutes to the CCG and let you know as soon as we have a response.

Dr Carpenter and I have taken a look at the accompanying leaflet and questionnaire and we feel that a better reflection of our current position would be presented if the wording of the paragraph below were amended to read as below. We cannot guarantee a town centre solution due to lack of funding and opportunity to expand, so an alternative solution away from the town centre would have to be supported by the council to ensure continued access for patients:-

**d) Health and other Emergency Services**

Current health service accommodation is fragmented with medical, dental and care services on different sites. The facilities meet present needs, but must expand to accommodate expected population growth and provide a wider range of services expected of modern healthcare. A joined-up approach is necessary to meet future needs through improved and larger accommodation, providing easy access for all service users with adequate parking and links with public transport.

I also feel that an additional line should be added on page 2 in the section :- ‘The key issues for the review are’: saying something like ‘fragmented healthcare provision with no parking facilities’. This clearly defines the issue and follows the example of the rest of the list.
