

# Ledbury Cemetery Memorial Safety Inspection



Ledbury Town Council recently commissioned Teleshore to conduct an inspection of the Memorials in Ledbury Cemetery. The following memorials have been identified as a health and safety risk and therefore require repairs. It is the responsibility of all Deed owners to keep their memorials in a safe and maintained condition.

If correspondence is not forthcoming from a family member during the three months from the placing of this notice on 28.09.2020, Ledbury Town Council will arrange any memorials that are deemed unsafe to be laid flat on the ground. Ledbury Town Council have systems in place to control the risks from memorials to their employees, contractors and owe a general duty of care to visitors and other members of the public. Responsibilities are also set out in various legislation covering burial grounds, e.g. the Local Authorities' Cemeteries Order 1977 (LACO).

Ledbury Town Council do not have any obligation to restore memorials to their original condition but to remove the hazard, and therefore the risk of injury from any unsafe memorial.
