## News Release 29<sup>th</sup> June 2021 Ledbury Town Council to stage two NDP drop in sessions and issues a call for residents' favourite views

Ledbury Town Council's consultation on the revision of the Neighbourhood Development Plan continues until July 16<sup>th</sup> with a 'call for favourite views' and two drop-in sessions to be staged under the Market House. Many responses to the public consultation questionnaire have been already been received and everyone 16 or over is encouraged to complete the survey. If anyone has not yet received their copy of the leaflet and questionnaire they should contact the Council by email to <u>clerk@ledburytowncouncil.gov.uk</u> or they can access them via this QR code.



Now COVID-19 restrictions have eased somewhat, two drop-in consultation sessions are to be held under the Market House on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2pm – 6pm and Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> July 9am to 1pm. Everyone who attends will have the opportunity to ask questions about the proposed revisions to the plan although numbers at any time may have to be controlled as Covid-19 restrictions will still apply.

The Council is also seeking residents' input on their 'Favourite local views and landscapes' asking them to send in photographs or drawings with some words about why the view or landscape matters to them. This will help the Neighbourhood Development Team to understand what aspects of landscape and townscape are valued by local people so that they can be protected and enhanced. We also hope to hold an exhibition of entries later in the year or even publish them.

Submissions should be sent to the Town Council, preferably by email to <u>clerk@ledburytowncouncil.gov.uk</u> or by post to Ledbury Town Council Offices, Church Street, Ledbury, HR8 1DH and should reach the Council by Friday,-16<sup>th</sup> July. Neighbourhood Plans remain current for 2 years from adoption so an update is due, and in particular, feedback on whether or not the town wishes to incorporate a 'settlement boundary' in the plan is now sought because the suggestions for a settlement boundary were not accepted by the examiner in the current plan. Incorporating a settlement boundary has always been seen by the Council as priority matter for this revision.
