# REQUESTS FROM MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC – REGULAR LITTER PICKS

# Purpose of Report

The purpose of this report is to ask Members of the Planning, Economy & Tourism Committee to consider whether the Council could hold regular litter picking sessions around the town.

# **Detailed Information**

On Sunday, 9 June Ledbury Town Council organised a community litter pick in and around the town.

The Community Engagement Officer set up this event as part of the Great Big Green Week and hosted a coffee morning afterward to thank the volunteers for their hard work. Not only did the volunteers fill 8 bags of rubbish, but It was a great way for residents to come together and socialise.

During the event, several people asked if the Council could hold regular litter picks, and since then, the Community Engagement Officer has received many requests to make this a recurring activity.

The correspondence below was the sent to the Town Clerk via email.

We attended the last litter pick and are happy to do some more. We travel quite a bit so it would be great to have a list of several litter pick dates so we stand a better chance of being able to attend. I expect a number of others would also volunteer if they were at varying times and days of the week so they can be fitted around work or regular commitments. Perhaps worth linking with schools for a kids litter pick and make it fun like a treasure hunt or game with little low cost prizes...make it something for the school hols pick accompanied by parent/guardian...might provide entertainment for an hour or half hour! Or maybe a run and pick with the Ledbury harriers but not restrict it to members, it might encourage people to join.

# **Recommendation**
