Reichswald Forest War Cemetery was created after the Second World War when burials were brought in from all over western Germany and is the largest Commonwealth cemetery in the country. Some of those members of the land forces buried there died in the advance through Reichswald Forest in February 1945. Others died crossing the Rhine, where landings were made by the 6th Airborne Division from bases in England. There are now 7,594 Commonwealth servicemen of the Second World War buried or commemorated in the cemetery. .

Thomas Taylor is buried in Plot 58. Row H. Grave 11.
